#### English Literature Session for Experienced AP Teachers – Dr. R. Diyanni George Orwell and the AP English Courses and Exams

We know George Orwell best, perhaps, as the author of two brilliant allegorical fictions: the parable of *Animal Farm* and the dystopia of *1984*. There is, however, another Orwell, a more intriguing and important writer than the author of his two best-known books. This other Orwell is the incomparable essayist, among the very finest writers of nonfiction in the twentieth century. In this workshop, we will consider Orwell as a writer of ideas, whether those ideas appear in novels, essays, political journalism, book reviews, or other miscellaneous prose. We will analyze sample passages from *1984* and *The Road to Wigan Pier* and consider them in light of the AP English Literature and Language exams. We will analyze a few of Orwell's briefer essays with a view to considering their rhetorical and literary strategies and effects in conjunction with the two AP English courses and exams.

#### **English Literature Session for new AP Teachers** – Dr. Adell Nyberg An Introduction to AP Literature and Ensuring Student Success

Information will be provided about the AP English Literature Program and Exam enabling teachers new to AP English Literature to become familiar and comfortable with the program. Participants will utilize various style analysis techniques and will practice these skills on past AP Literature Exams that are no longer available online thus increasing the number of resources available for teachers to use in their AP classrooms.
