Methodology

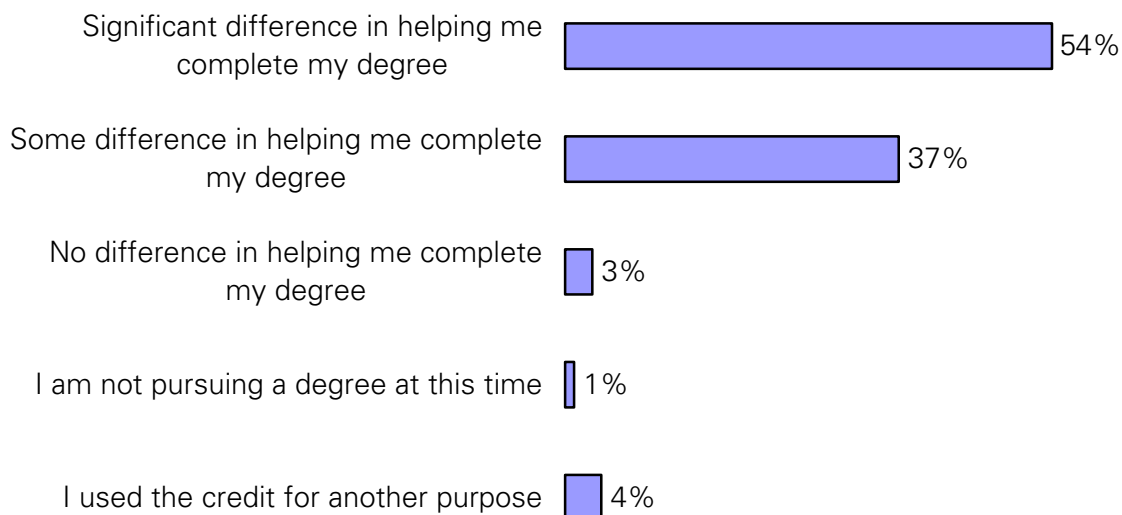
Students earning a score of 50 or higher on one or more of the 35 CLEP examination titles from July 1, 2003, to June 30, 2004, were surveyed. A total of 35,654 surveys were distributed: 4,089 students provided responses; 3,365 students completed the entire survey.

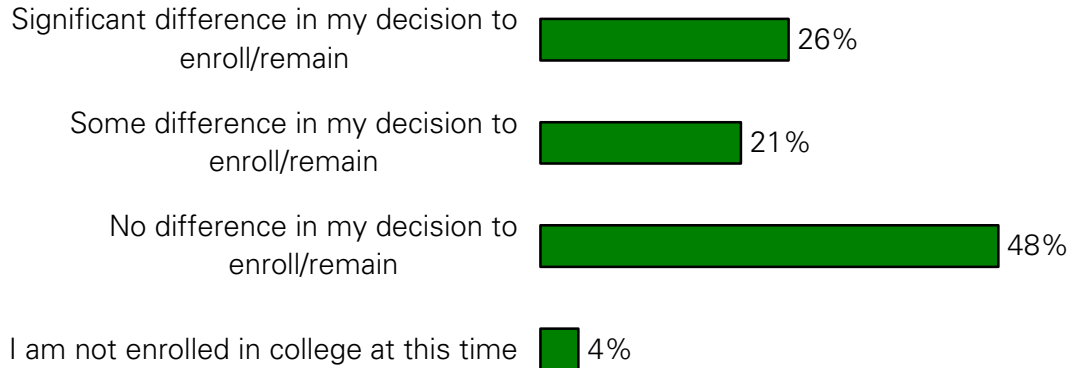
1. Have you earned credit for the CLEP examination you took?



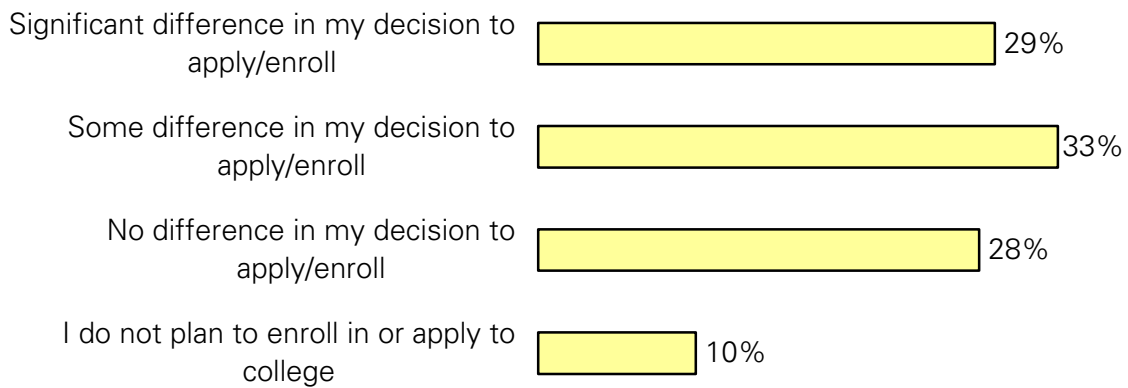
2. Please indicate the most accurate statement with regard to the CLEP exam(s) you took and your ability to complete your degree.



3. Did your institution's policy regarding the granting of credit for CLEP make a difference in your decision to enroll/remain at your institution?

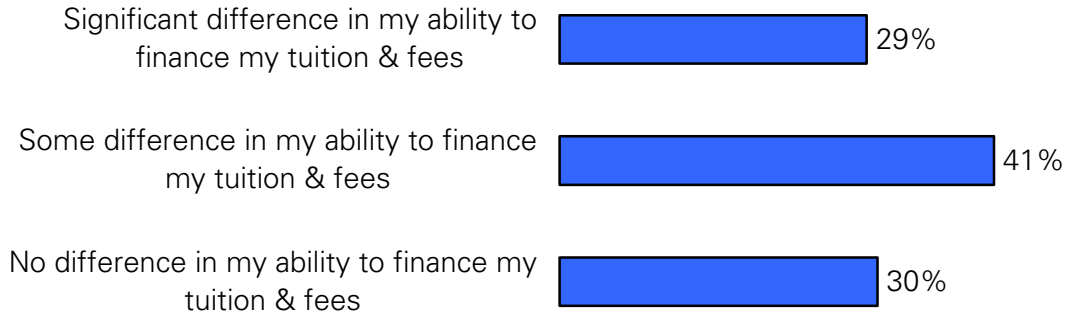


4. If you are not currently enrolled in college, please indicate how the CLEP policies of the institutions you are considering would affect your decision to apply/enroll.

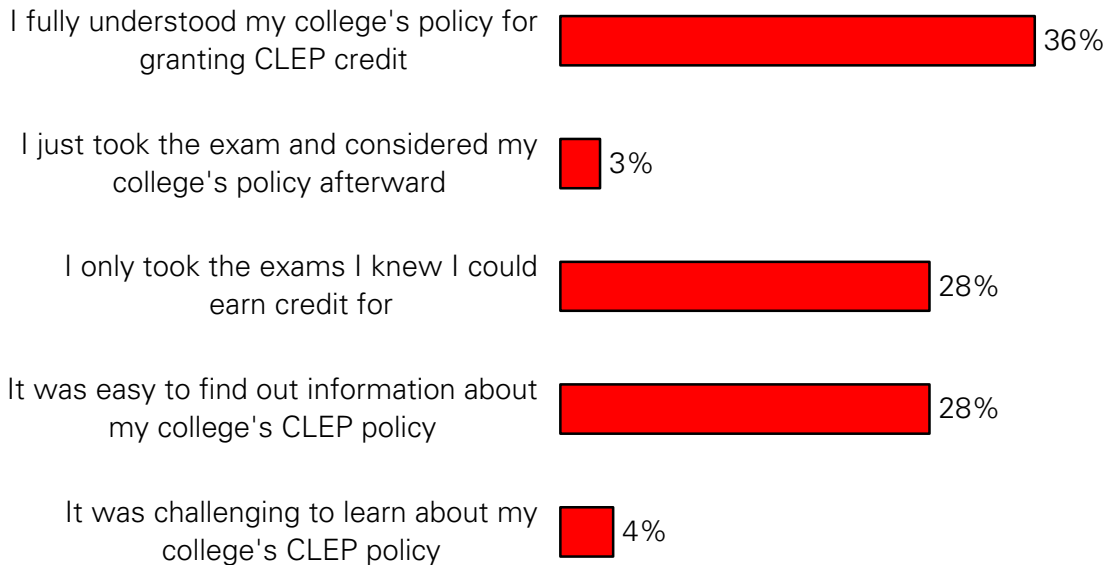


5. Please describe the extent to which earning CLEP credit has helped you finance your education.

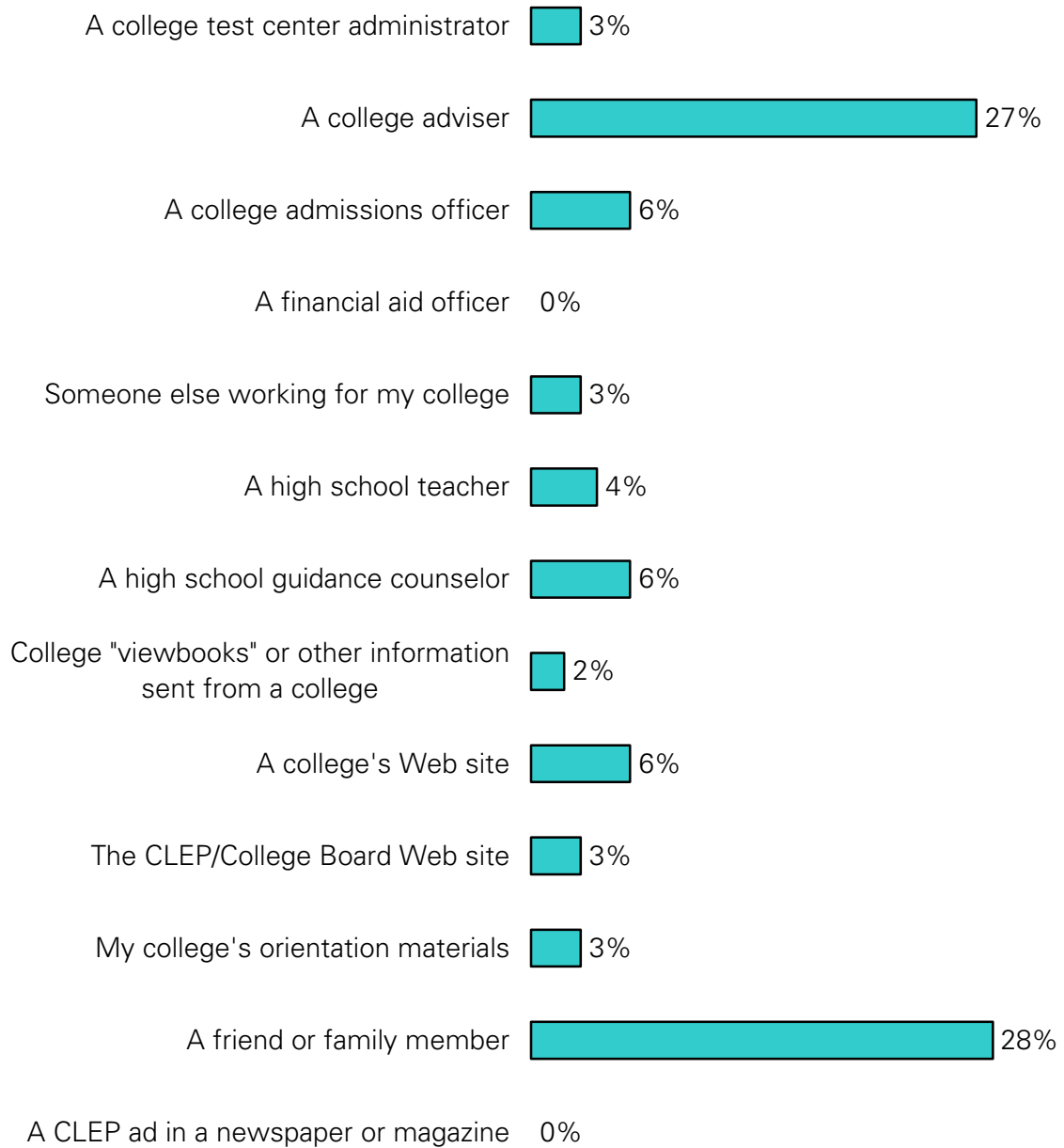

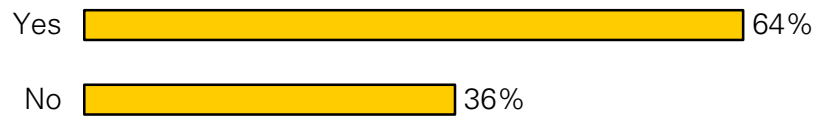
