New Counselor Workshop

June 15–16, 2014

The New Counselor Workshop (pre-institute option) is designed specifically for overseas college counselors with one year or less of experience in college admission counseling. This hands-on workshop will provide participants with basics on setting up a college counseling program at an international school.
