Approximately 36% of the students took AP Examinations in more than one year. The figures below show the cumulative number of exams individual students took from the years 1994 to 1997 and from 2004 to 2007. Note, for example, that 140,913 students took three or more AP Exams in the years 1994 to 1997 and were therefore potentially eligible for sophomore standing; in 2007, 451,154 students had three or more AP Exams on their records. By 2007, 8,427 students had amassed 9 AP Exams, 4,596 had 10 exams, 2,358 had 11 exams, 1,225 had 12 exams, 565 students had 13 exams, 314 had 14 exams, 182 had 15 exams, 62 had 16 exams, 37 had 17 exams, 20 had 18 exams, 13 had 19 exams, 7 had 20 exams, 5 had 21 exams, 1 had 23 exams, and 1 student had amassed 26 AP Exams.
